The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 12, dated 17.01.2017, registered under Sections 379-B/323 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

2. It is submitted by Ld. counsel for the petitioner that his client has been in detention since his arrest on 18.05.2017, even though he was not named in the F.I.R.

3. Peruse the case diary; The available material against the petitioner does not appear to be sufficient to warrant his further detention in

the case, at this stage.

4. For this reason, the present petition is also allowed and the petitioner, namely Gurdas Singh son of Harbans Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Area Magistrate with a further direction to meet the Investigating Officer once in a week till the submission of challan.
