It is contended that FIR No.25, dated 26th March, 2017 was registered under Sections 376, 354, 506, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt. on a complaint filed by the petitioner.

It is further contended that she was attacked by some of the accused on 24th May, 2017. She is being pressurized to withdraw her case. In this respect a representation dated 25th May, 2017 (Anneuxe P-1) was submitted before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar. At this stage, it is submitted that respondent No.2 be directed to look into the matter and take action.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation dated

25th May, 2017 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon if any/as may be required.

It is reiterated that no opinion whatsoever is being expressed on the merits of this case.
