ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner through the instant petition has sought permission to go abroad. He is facing trial in FIR No.176 dated 21.07.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the FIR are that he had illegally obtained arms licence by producing a false declaration that he is a citizen of India. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is a citizen of India as well as the citizen of Germany. He also contends that even earlier the petitioner had travelled to Germany after registration of the FIR and he had returned to India. The wife of the petitioner is a heart patient and the petitioner has to go to Germany to attend to his business for a period of two months.

Heard.

The petitioner is a citizen of Germany and his wife is suffering from heart ailment. He has sought permission for a period of two months. It is not the case that the petitioner has ever absconded from law. The petitioner can be permitted to go abroad, subject to adequate surety.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be permitted to go to Germany from 25.09.2017 for a period of two months and he shall come back to India by 23.11.2017. He shall submit adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court before leaving India.
