This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 98 dated 22.06.2016, registered under Sections 498-A, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No. 3, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

On 25.07.2017, the petitioner through her counsel had submitted that she, on her own behalf and on behalf of her son, was ready to settle all disputes. Pursuant to the said statement made, notice of motion was issued with a direction to the petitioner to bring a sum of Rs. 22,000/- towards litigation expenses. The matter was taken up on 11.10.2017, on which date, it was brought to the notice of this Court that litigation expenses had not been paid and further time was given to the petitioner to bring the

same on the next date of hearing. A direction was also given to the parties to be present in Court on the date so fixed.

This matter has been taken up today. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner herein is not coming forth.

In view of the fact that there has been non-compliance of the orders so passed, the instant petition is being dismissed.
