Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.631 dated 23.04.2017, under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar. The petitioner was arrested on 24.04.2017 and is in jail since then.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official, submits that the petitioner and other co-accused were indulging in printing of fake currency. The petitioner was found to have ₹3,000/- total in the denomination of ₹100/- currency notes. She further states that there is no other case against the petitioner. Trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall file undertaking before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar or any other kind of offence. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
