Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. In FIR No.411 dated 25.6.2017, under Sections 7/13 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, the petitioner was arrested on 26.6.2017 and is in jail since then. The petitioner is stated to have demanded Rs.1500/-. The petitioner is working as a trainee Assistant Pharmacist with Govt. Hospital, Fatehabad. Counsel for the State submits that the services of the petitioner would be dispensed with within one week from today. Statement is accepted.

Looking to the allegations against the petitioner and the amount involved, I am inclined to grant bail as it is no use continuing his detention pending trial as it will take its own time. Hence, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate.
