ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.6 dated 05.01.2016 under Sections 452/323/324/326/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station C Division, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the neighbours and the matter has now been compromised. He also states that complainant has fully recovered from the injuries.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the complainant has indeed recovered from the injuries and has compromised the matter on his own accord.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 26.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has sent her report dated 14.08.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the neighbours and the matter has now been compromised. The injured has fully recovered from the injuries.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 6 dated 05.01.2016 under Sections 452/323/324/326/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station C Division, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
