INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Rup Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.44 dated 22.02.2016, registered at Police Station Badhra, District Bhiwani, under Sections 323, 325, 302, 506 and 34 of IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned State counsel has brought into notice of this Court that trial is almost complete and case is fixed for recording the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

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As the trial is almost complete, therefore, no ground is made out to grant the benefit of bail to the accused.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 03.03.2016, trial Court is directed to dispose of the case as early as possible.
