It is contended that in the incident which took place on 12th July, 2017 at 5.30 pm, the petitioner along with her husband, received injuries. Reference is made to the medico-legal reports (Annexures P-1 and P-2). However FIR No.0177, dated 13th July, 2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC at Police Station Israna, District Panipat has been wrongly registered against the petitioner's husband. The police, it is submitted, is not taking any action on the complaints (Annexures P-3 and P-4) moved by the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the file.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Panipat to look into the representations dated 12th July, 2017 and 15th July,

2017 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon if any/as may be required.

It is reiterated that no opinion whatsoever is being expressed on the merits of this case.
