Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.296 dated 17.05.2017, under Sections 120-B, 166, 167, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 7/13, 13(1), C, D of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official, states that the challan has since been filed.
