Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official present in Court today to assist him, submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded to the effect that their parents have reconciled to the marriage and they no longer require any protection.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, though with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to otherwise ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.

However, the observation made by this Court that any proceedings by a competent person in terms of the provisions of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006, would not be barred, would continue to enure.
