Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that pursuant to the order dated 30.01.2017, the petitioners have joined investigation, but they are named in the suicide note, as two of the three persons who allegedly had received money from the deceased, that was not returned him.

Keeping in view the fact that the investigation of the FIR is based on a suicide note of the deceased, which is already in possession of the investigating agency, I see no reason for the custodial interrogation of the petitioners at this stage at least.

Consequently, the order dated 30.01.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
