ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 169 dated 9.4.2017 registered under Sections 120-B, 379, 411, 429, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in judicial lock up since 6.5.2017. He further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, he was not named and later on, he has been involved on the disclosure statement of the co-accused Nirpal Singh @ Pala, who has already been granted regular bail vide order dated 25.8.2017 passed in **CRM-M-30065-2017, Nirpal Singh @ Pala vs. State of Haryana.**

It is further submitted that petitioner is already on bail in other cases and in three other FIRs, he has already been acquitted. He further submits that challan has already been submitted and petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in Court and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, does not dispute the factual position as well as the custody period already undergone by the petitioner.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
