ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.146 dated 05.06.2017, under Sections 452, 323, 506 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has caused simple injuries on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant. He further states that the petitioner himself has suffered five injuries in the said incident and the petitioner earlier had filed a complaint for registration of FIR against the complainant party as they had mis-behaved with female relative of the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 26.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Judge Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 26.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
