Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.84 dated 14.05.2017, under Sections 365, 323, 325, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Radaur, Yamuna Nagar.

The petitioner was arrested on 05.07.2017 and is in jail since then. Looking to the offence in which the petitioner seeks bail, it is clear that the offence under Section 365 of IPC is triable by the Magistrate. Challan having been filed, it is of no use keeping the petitioner in detention as under trial since the trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
