These are the petitions filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.45 dated 14.05.2014 registered under Sections 22/25/61/85 of NDPS at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners were arrested and in jail since then. The petitioner-Satnam Singh was driving the motorcycle while the other petitioner-Budh Singh was the pillion rider. They were stopped by the police on suspicion and found in the bag the contraband substance.

No other offences have been reported against both the petitioners. Eighty (80) bottles of Rexcof and one thousand (1000) tablets of Carisole, were found in the bag. The represented samples were sent for analysis.

Looking to the period spent by the petitioners in jail, the following order is passed:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-27683 OF 2016 & CRL. MISC. No.3016 OF 2017 are allowed.
- (ii) Both the petitioners be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
