This is a petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.53 dated 17.05.2017 under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC and Sections 3(1)(W), 3(1)(ZC), 3(2)(V), 3(2)(VA) SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhand.

This Court was pleased to pass the following order on 27.07.2017 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the provisions as mentioned in the FIR would not be applicable qua the petitioner in the instant case while submitting that the co-accused had already been given protection. The petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Mr. Chander Pal Tiwana, Advocate, has appeared and filed vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant and opposed the bail application.

Notice of motion for 04.12.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be

released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for investigation any further.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State confirms the aforesaid fact.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 27.07.2017 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
