SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioner, who is an accused in F.I.R. No. 0283, dated 24.05.2017, under Sections 387 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, (Annexure P-1), has prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings pending in the Court of the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahadurgarh, on the basis of compromise.

[2]. With the intervention of respectable and elderly people of the

society, the complainant has arrived at a settlement with the accused vide Mutual Compromise (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by him. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahadurgarh, vide report dated 11.09.2017, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel.

[4]. In view of the report of the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bahadurgarh, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/ accused person.

[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R. No. 0283, dated 24.05.2017, under Sections 387 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioner.
