**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.162 dated 02.11.2016 under sections 307, 382, 323, 148, 149, 506, 341, 427 IPC (Sections 395, 397 and 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Lalru, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that only minor injuries on non vital parts of the body of complainant were caused in the occurrence and the offence under Section 307 IPC is not made out. He further states that there is no allegation of robbery against the petitioner which would constitute offence under Sections 395 and 397 IPC. The petitioner is in custody ever since 12.04.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Naib Singh states that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature and are on non-vital parts of the body.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody for over 3 months, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Devender Pal @ Dev is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
