TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.567, dated 26.06.2016, under Sections 379/414/411/201 IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, petitioner is a scrap dealer and who deals in stolen vehicle parts. He is sought to be implicated in the present case on the disclosure statement of co-accused, Jagmohan Singh @ Mohna and who in turn has stated that he used to procure the stolen vehicles from the petitioner. The recovery has been made from co-accused, Jagmohan Singh @ Mohna i.e. a pickup truck as also 57 tyres and tubes. No recovery has been effected from the present petitioner.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented on 15.12.2016. Charges have already been framed but the trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 17.10.2016.

Even though, the present petition has been opposed by learned State

counsel on the ground that the petitioner is involved in a number of other criminal proceedings and in which there are similar allegations/offences, yet counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been granted bail in such cases.

Co-accused, Jagmohan Singh @ Mohna and on whose disclosure statement, present petitioner stands implicated has been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in the light of order dated 27.01.2017 passed in CRM-M-42845-2016.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Hisar,
