In FIR No.85 dated 05.07.2013, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar, the petitioners seek quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondents no.2 to 4 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court vide order dated 14.12.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned JMIC, Amritsar stating that the statements have been recorded and the

compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No.85 dated 05.07.2013, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
