This Court had made an order dated 24.08.2016 granting *ad interim* order for the reasons made in that order. One of the reasons given is that the petitioner was liable to be given a chance to settle the matter.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and now there is a report from the Mediation Centre that there is failure of mediation. Looking to the nature of offence against the petitioner and his further attitude to stick to his guns, I think the petitioner would not be entitled to grant of the said relief of grant of anticipatory bail.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner for anticipatory bail is dismissed.

Interim order dated 24.08.2016 stands vacated.
