The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0041 dated 08.07.2017 registered under Section 384 IPC at Police Station City-2, District Mansa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 28.07.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but he was convicted and sentenced for life imprisonment by the trial Court. This Court had suspended his sentence in appeal.

In that view of the matter, I think the petitioner would be entitled to grant of anticipatory bail.

Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-26971 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Interim order dated 28.07.2017 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) The petitioner shall report to the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed there.
 - (b) The petitioner shall give undertaking to the police that he will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (iii) In case of violation of the above condition on the part of the petitioner, the liberty is reserved in favour of the State to apply for cancellation of bail.
