Petitioners seek regular bail in case FIR No.74 dated 01.10.2016 registered under Sections 458/323/427/148/149 IPC at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

Complainant Bhinder Singh alleged that on 30.09.2016 at about 8.15 P.M, when he entered his house, he saw the accused Baljinder Singh @ Balla, Gurwinder Singh, Sarabjeet Kaur, Pargat Singh, Gurjant Singh son of Harnek Singh, Gurjant Singh son of Gurdial Singh and Pooja in his house. Petitioner No.1 who was armed with a *gandasa* gave a blow on the gate of the house. Petitioner No.2 gave a dang blow on the wrist of right arm of mother of the complainant. Apparently, injury attributed to Baljinder Singh @ Balla (petitioner No.2) was found to be simple in nature. No injury was attributed to petitioner No.1 except unlawful assembly as alleged by the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC, Narender Singh stated that recovery has already been effected from the petitioners and challan is yet to be presented. Petitioners are in custody since 18.12.2016.

Looking to the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners be enlarged on regular bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
