ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.133 dated 31.12.2016, under Sections 365, 342, 323, 324, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature and are on non-vital parts of the body. He further contends that prima facie offence under Section 365 IPC is not made out inasmuch as per the allegations in the FIR, two unidentified persons had abducted the complainant in broad day light at 11:00 a.m.

This Court vide order dated 28.07.2017, had directed the petitioners to join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail subject to the

satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 28.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
