Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that petitioner has since joined the investigation and rendered full cooperation therein. He has contended that as per his information offences under Sections 452 and 336 IPC have been deleted from the FIR.

Responding to that, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh from Police Station Sadar, Malaut conceded those facts informing that the weapon has also been got recovered by the petitioner and in that way his custodial interrogation is not required.

Under the circumstances, the interim bail granted to the petitioner on 27.7.2017 is made absolute, subject to his fulfilling

conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
