The petitioners are seeking a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 7.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 16.02.1999 and that of petitioner No.2 is 01.01.1994. Copies of Aadhaar cards of both the petitioners is annexed as Annexures P-1 and P-2. They are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 24.07.2017. The photographs and marriage certificate in this regard are annexed as Annexures P-3 and P-4. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 24.07.2017 (Annexure P-5) to Station House Officer, Police Station Zirakpur, District Mohali, but no action has so far been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Mand, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of '**Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another', JT 2006(6) SC 173**', the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.
