The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 24, dated 05.04.2017, under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307, 324 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Balongi, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was armed with *danda* and had kicked the complainant but only one injury has been found on the complainant as per MLR, which is attributed to Ricky, the main accused. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over two months ever since the date of his arrest on 25.05.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over two months and the only injury on the person of the complainant is not attributed to him, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Vijay Kumar @ Kala is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
