Earlier petition i.e. CRM-M No.17246 of 2017 filed by the petitioner was dismissed on merits vide order dated 24.05.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks parity with the co-accused Jarnail Singh who has been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 20.07.2017. The case of Jarnail Singh was not considered by the High Court on earlier occasion. There is no change in circumstance. Grant of anticipatory bail to Jarnail Singh cannot be viewed to be a change in circumstance for the purposes of re-consideration of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
