Petitioner, who claims to be 57 years of age, has some grievances against her son, Harmandeep Singh/respondent No. 4 and her daughter-in-law, Shilpa Dutt/respondent No. 5. She claims that she is being harassed and threatened by respondents No. 4 and 5 that they will occupy her property. She also annexed two photographs (*Annexure P-2*) depicting the injuries.

It comes out that the petitioner has made a representation dated 13.06.2017 (*Annexure P-3*) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Bathinda, leveling allegations of harassment against respondents No. 4 and 5.

In the circumstances, present petition is disposed with a direction that a copy of representation dated 13.06.2017 (*Annexure P-3*) be sent to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, who shall look into the matter and take necessary action in accordance with law. The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is also directed to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioner and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioner, corrective measures be taken to protect her life and liberty.
