The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 26, dated 13.03.2016, under Sections 307, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-19, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the allegations against the petitioner are that he is stated to have hit the complainant on his head with a sword but the matter has been compromised. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for more than five and half months ever since the date of his arrest on 17.02.2017.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over five months and the matter has been compromised, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Nitish @ Shanty is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
