crime of assault the people in the Hospital. The relief of anticipatory

bail cannot be extended to such type of persons.

In that view of the matter, both these petitions stand dismissed. Interim order dated 31.07.2017 in CRM-M-27224 of 2017 is vacated. Police is directed to arrest the petitioners immediately.
