

stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel and only simple injuries have been caused to the complainant and the matter has now been compromised with the intervention of the respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.31 dated 07.08.2013, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Talwara/Mushera Fery, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P/1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
