This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for issuance of direction to official respondents herein not to harass and humiliate the petitioners.

In the order dated 07.07.2017, it was noted that the parties had compromised the dispute and they were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of their statement regarding the genuineness of the compromise. In pursuance of the direction, a report has been received from JMIC, Bhiwani, stating that the compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure or coercion from any one and the same appears to be genuine one.

Since the matter has been compromised and the parties are residing together, the instant petition, seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners, is rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.

The litigation expenses, that had been deposited in the Registry of this Court, be released to respondent No. 4 herein.
