After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his argument to the extent that personal appearance of the petitioner – Abhishek Sharma, who is resident of New Delhi be exempted before the trial Court at Rajpura.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application before the trial Court. The trial Court shall grant exemption to the petitioner from personal appearance on the condition that he will be represented through his counsel and will not object to any evidence being produced during the course of trial by the complainant and he will appear before the trial Court as and when required for the purpose of putting up any documents.
