Prayer in this petition is for transferring the investigation of case FIR No.0222, dated 25.06.2017 under Sections 201, 302 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station, Jind Sadar, District Jind to some other independent investigating agency.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind-II has already been filed. As per this reply, it is submitted that the investigation was going on. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub-Inspector Ram Kumar, who is present in Court today, has stated that subsequently, on 29.09.2017, the report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. has been presented against four accused persons, namely, Sanjay, Krishan, Sikander and Meenu @ Parveen. It is further submitted that with regard to one more co-accused, namely, Jai Bhagwan, the police is in process of conducting a polygraphic test and on the basis of a polygraphic test, if required, additional challan will be presented against this accused person.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered as infructuous at the stage, granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court by way of moving an application for further investigation, if required, in terms of Section 173(8) of Cr.P.C.
