The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 165, dated 16.08.2016, registered under Sections 302/506/336/148/149/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.
