INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Simranjit Singh @ Prince has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.193 dated 21.09.2016, registered at Police Station Derabassi, District S.A.S.Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 307, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR, however, injured has named him. As per the allegations, all the accused fired shots and the complainant received nine bullet injuries. The injured has been examined-in-chief only and case is at preliminary stage.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that there is every possibility of tampering with the evidence, if the petitioner-accused is released on bail at this stage.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
