The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 146, dated 05.06.2017, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 5, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has caused simple injuries to the complainant. He further states that the altercation took place as the complainant had mis-behaved with the sister of the petitioner.

This Court, vide order dated 28.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Judge

Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 28.07.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 28.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
