Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.203 dated 12.11.2016 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, Ludhiana.

None is present on behalf of the petitioner even on the second call.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of HC Charanjit Singh, submits that the petitioner is a dismissed Head Constable from Punjab Police. It is further submitted that the petitioner was dismissed in the year 2005 and subsequently, he is involved in as many as 14 FIRs and in all the FIRs, allegations against the petitioner are that he, by posing himself to be a Punjab Police official, in police uniform, takes money from the complainants on pretext of getting their work done.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is involved in 14 FIRs, as per the list supplied by learned State counsel, copy of which is taken on record, no ground for grant of regular bail at this stage is made out.
