The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.155 dated 06.06.2017, under Section 61 of Excise Act and Sections 120-B, 420, 473 IPC, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR are that from co-accused Rajesh Kumar, 800 boxes of liquor were recovered and the number plate of the canter was found to be forged. It was only on the statement of Rajesh Kumar that the petitioner has also been arrayed as an accused.

This Court, by the order dated 28.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and he was to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sushil Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 28.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
