INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.123 dated 29.05.2017 under Section 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Panipat Sadar, District Panipat.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 31.07.2017 passed by this Court, present petitioner was directed to join the

investigation. Learned State counsel informed this Court that the petitioner has not joined the investigation. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that he has also no instructions as to why the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

As the petitioner has not complied with the order passed by this Court, therefore, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
