Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.3 and 4 to decide representation dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) as well as representation dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby specific complaint was given by the petitioner for taking legal action against private respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3 i.e. Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to look into the contents of representation dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of aforesaid representation (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law. It being a matrimonial dispute, it is expected that the Superintendent of Police concerned shall try to resolve the matter between the parties by interacting with them.
