Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 100 dated 21.5.2017 under Sections 379B/34/413 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner along with co-accused snatched a purse containing Rs.700/- along with photocopy of Aadhar Card and some documents. He further contended that the petitioner is in custody from last about 3 months and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel on the basis of custody certificate affirmed that the petitioner is in custody for the last two months and ten days. However, allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, therefore, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 23.5.2017; decision of

the case still to take some more time; no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

The petition stands allowed.
