The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.184 dated 25th October, 2017, registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the I.P.C.') at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that an amicable compromise of the financial dispute leading up to the FIR in question, has been arrived at between his client and the complainant.

Ld. State counsel on instructions from ASI-Darshan Singh, Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda concedes to the aforesaid submission.

In the circumstances and in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his surrendering before the Ld. Court below on appropriate terms and conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C..
