The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.125 dated 03.11.2016 registered under Section 302 IPC (Sections 201, 379, 149 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

I have perused the statements of eye witnesses.

Learned State counsel submits that the post mortem report shows the opinion that the death was due to throttling.

Looking to the statements of eye witnesses at least insofar as the petitioners are concerned, prima facie, there is no evidence against them.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, who are women. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-27370 OF 2017 is allowed.

(ii) The petitioners be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
