Petitioner-Dharamvir Singh alias Dharma has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.220 dated 21.08.2016, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, Punjab, under Sections 379, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 472 IPC and Section 411 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the allegations, three stolen scooters and nine stolen motor-cycles have been recovered from the present petitioner.

The petitioner has been in custody since 22.08.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. All the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Moreover, co-accused, Avtar Singh, in the similar circumstances, has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 04.05.2017 passed in CRM-M-13914-2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
