This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 84 dated 04.08.2011, registered at Police Station "C" Division, Amritsar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been appearing before the trial Court through out and that on 14.10.2014 she had been informed by her counsel that she had been acquitted, after which on 16.10.2014 she could not appear in Court, leading to her being declared to be a Proclaimed Offender.

She was arrested thereafter on 28.04.2016 (one and a half years later) and she has been in custody for 10 months thereafter.

Having considered the above and seeing the past conduct of the petitioner, I do not think that this is a fit case to admit her to bail, at this stage.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
