This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 242 dated 20.06.2016, registered under Sections 307, 354-B of the IPC; Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act, at Police Station Narnaud.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and she has not supported the version of the prosecution.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner. She submits that out of total 27 witnesses, statements of 15 witnesses have been recorded.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and she has not supported the prosecution version and the trial is likely to take some

time to conclude, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
