Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take appropriate action on the representations dated 31.05.2017 and 27.06.2017 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to decide petitioner's representation dated 31.05.2017(Annexure P-4).
